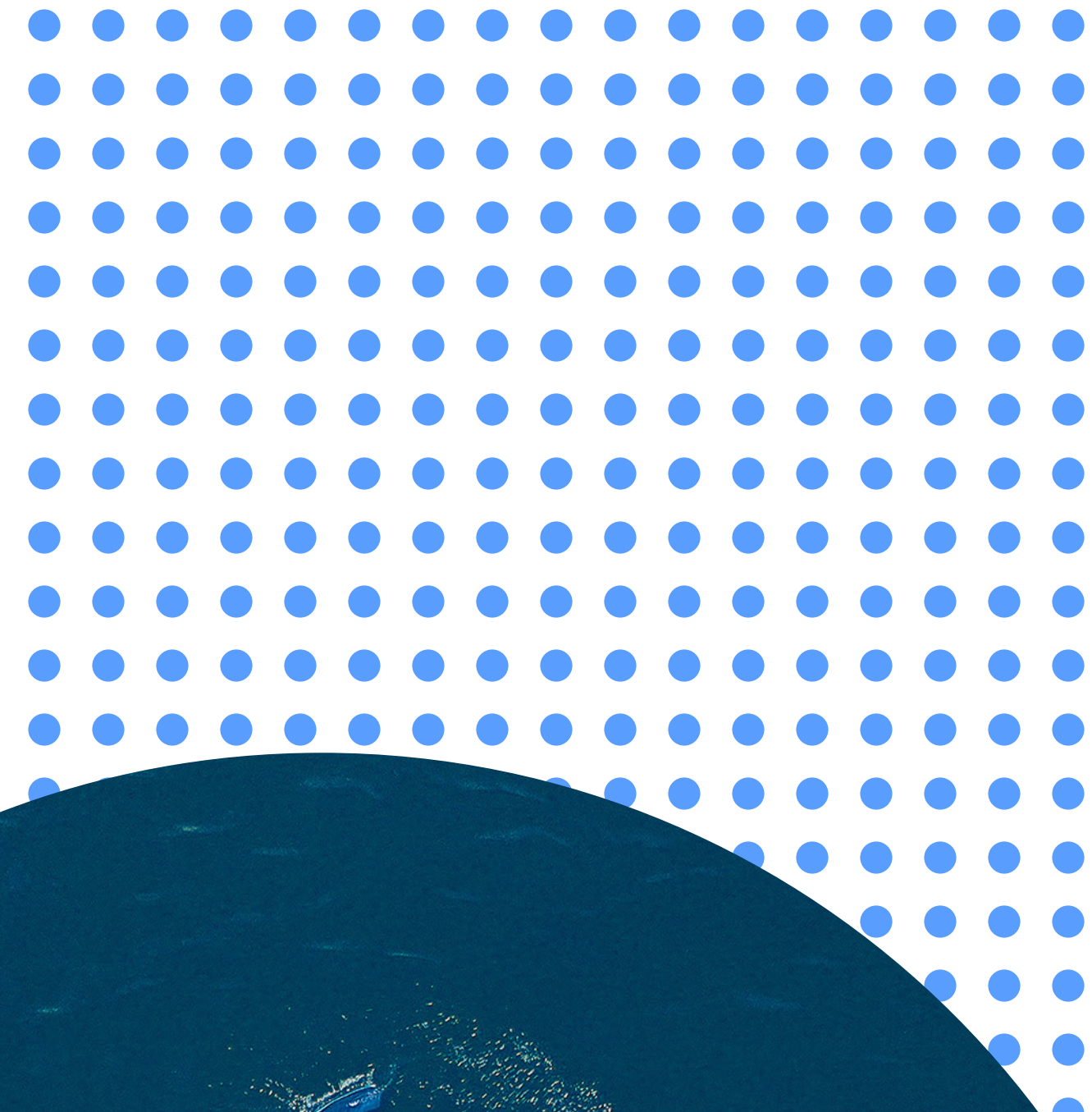

What is Leadership in Safety

Before starting to look at how people behave in our workplace, we need to understand the impact of leadership and culture. We'll explore different leadership styles, including your own, and encourage you to look at things differently.



Avoiding Failure and Creating Excellence
